

Boat Host Information

- Be at Dunedin Municipal Marina between 9:00 and 9:30 a.m. (Families to arrive at 9:30 a.m.). There is a boat ramp at the Dunedin Marina with parking for trucks and trailers.
- Have your boat fueled and ready to go prior to 9:30 a.m. Fuel is available at marker 1 just north of Dunedin Marina.
- Boat Host drivers meeting at 9:30 a.m. at Dunedin Municipal Marina. We will have a light breakfast available.
- In your Boat Host bag are T-shirts for you and your registered guest. Please wear these shirts so that we can easily identify who is a Boat Host/Volunteer.
- Before boarding, leave at least one Boat Host on shore to help direct families to the location of your boat in the water.
- You will have the same family going to Caladesi and back to Dunedin Municipal Marina.
- All passengers are required to wear life preservers. Volunteers on dock will assist in putting them on before the family boards the boat.
- Please have a cooler with water on board.
- Please be aware of all passenger reactions while boat is moving and adjust speeds accordingly.
- Please acknowledge anything that might make your passengers experience more enjoyable! Slow down to point these things out (dolphins).
- We will spend a few hours on the island having lunch and interacting with the families, and then board your boat again at approx. 1:00-1:30 p.m. to bring the families back to Dunedin Municipal Marina. Volunteers will be there to assist with disembark.
- We will have a get together after the event either at the hotel or back at the island which you are welcome to attend and help celebrate a successful day!
